How to mount a box camera using a mounting bracket

This is your basic plastic mount; it is intended for indoor use. For outdoor use we would recommend using an outdoor camera housing and bracket for a a box camera, or a weather proof camera.



The base of the mount can be un-screwed for easy installation. The holes at the base are for the screws. You can use screws for drywall or anchors and appropriate screws for harder walls.



After connecting the mount's base to the wall, connect the camera to the axle on the head of the mount. The axle will allow you to change the position of the camera after you have installed it to get the best angle for better view of the area you are monitoring.



After mounting the camera and connecting the video and power cables the end result would look like this:



***Note: it is possible to mount the camera from a ceiling. In that case, there should be a mounting bracket attached to the bottom of the camera. Take this bracket off and connect it to the top of the camera. Now connect the mount's axle to the bracket and hang it for the ceiling.**
